



# FEDERAL TAX CREDIT FOR INSTALLING ENERGY EFFICIENT WINDOWS AND DOORS

Homeowners can now claim a Federal tax credit of up to \$1,500 for upgrading their primary residence with energy efficient windows and exterior doors. This Federal Tax Credit means that homeowners can reduce their income tax by up to thirty percent of the purchase price (not including installation costs) of qualified products installed in 2009 and 2010. North Star manufactures products that qualify for this Federal Tax Credit.

## Qualifications

- Windows and doors must be installed between January 1, 2009 and December 31, 2010.
- Products must be installed in the taxpayer's primary residence.
- Qualified products must have NFRC certified U-Factor and Solar Heat Gain Coefficient (SHGC) ratings that do not exceed 0.30.
- Windows and doors must be for exterior use only.
